Adhering to Governor Pritzker's issuance of a statewide Stay-At-Home order effective Saturday, March 21, 2020 at 5:00 pm, our indoor facilities and buildings remain closed through Tuesday, April 7, 2020. Our classes and programs continue to be affected through this date as well.

At this time, the Tinley Park-Park District Board of Commissioners has decided to keep open-air park sites open and accessible for use. While we encourage all people to stay at home, walking, hiking, running and biking in our park system will remain allowable during posted hours. However, per the [Stay-At-Home Order](#), **all playgrounds are closed for public use through April 7, 2020.**

If you must get out, do so safely. Remember that groups of ten people or more are prohibited and **social distancing** must be practiced as required by the Governor's order.
