(All rules subject to change based on new/updated guidelines without notice.)

The safety of the members and staff is the priority of the Park District.

Arrival

- Capacity is regulated. You may experience delays. Please be patient.
- Members must wear a mask in all common areas (entering building, hallways, bathrooms, lobby, etc.)
- You may remove mask once on the track or basketball court.
- Check in with your current membership ID card.
- Bring only essential items, e.g., towel, mask, keys or basketball.

General Facility Restrictions and Changes

- Restrooms are open.
- Please wash and sanitize your hands frequently. Several hand sanitizing stations will be available.
- Touchless fillable water fountain available. Bring your own water bottle.
- Coffee room is closed.
- Lobby seating area is closed.
- Abide by current social distancing guidelines.

Facility Cleaning

- Restrooms cleaned per IDPH, DCEO, and CDC guidelines.
- Facility closed daily for deep cleaning: Monday-Friday 12:00-1:00pm and Saturdays 10:45-11:15am. No entrance/reservations during this time.

Track Usage

- No reservation required.
- Maximum of 60-minute usage per day.
- Maximum track capacity of 50 people.
- Locker area on the track available to change shoes and store belongings. Disinfect locker with provided wipes before and after use.
- Center lane closed except to pass other patrons.

Basketball Court Usage

- Pre-registration is required. See court schedule for registration numbers. You can register online via your household account or in person.
- Facility cannot guarantee availability of court time slots; registration is first come-first served.
- Maximum of one 50-minute court reservation per day.
- One household per basket. Playing with members from another household not allowed. All persons in household must be members.
